RULES:

3. MUST be completely homegrown flowers and greens/filler.
4. Open to anyone.
5. Should be in a vase or container that can be donated to Aase Haugen. We cannot guarantee the return of dishes. All entries become the property of Aase Haugen Senior Services and will be used to decorate the nursing home.
6. Judges' decisions are final.
